Sam Beasley, Next Champion?

Sam Beasley took on the best kart racers from across the country, including stars with a break in their NASCAR schedule, Jamie McMurray and AJ Almdinger, at the USA Rotax Grand Finals in Toole, Utah. Sam finished second to earn him a position on Team USA to compete against the worlds best kart racers, and champions from over 100 different countries at The Rotax World Finals at the Al Ain Raceway, (emirate of Abu Dhabi), the United Arab Emirates, in November.

Sam has raced in two SCCA F1600 Pro races. His first car race was at VIR where he set a new F1600 lap record. Sam has also raced a SCCA Formula Enterprise car, with his sights set on a SCCA National Championship.

The first time in the car, Sam qualified first for both days of the Mid-Ohio double National, and finished second both days to the defending SCCA National champion. Sam will race the Beaverun National in July and the Nelson Ledges National at the end of the August to qualify for the Run-Offs. Look for him to bring a ninth SCCA National championship to the family in September.

Sam is seventeen and will be a senior in high school this fall.

5. The Region Board shall consist of nine Trustees, the RE, Assistant RE, Recording Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Secretary. This Region Board will meet on a regular basis at a time and place determined by the members of said Board. All meetings, regular or special, shall be recorded and state the time, place, and purpose of the meeting. No member of the Region Board can give to another Region Board member the power to vote in his stead.

6. Chairperson of the Region Board

At the first meeting of the Region Board the members of the Board will elect a Chairperson from its members.

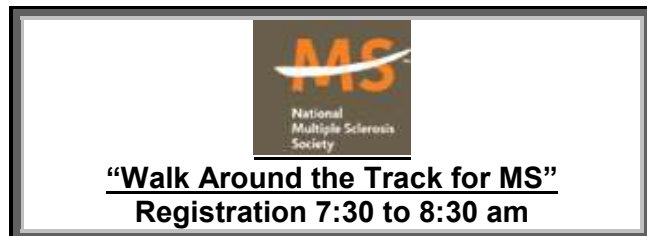
