HARD CHARGER AWARD

NEOHIO Region is proud to present the HARD CHARGER AWARD to the driver who gains the most positions in their race during the Firecracker National Races to be held on Sunday, July 3, 2011 at Nelson Ledges Race Course.

This award is based on the number of positions that a car moves up through the field from its starting position and is contingent upon a car's natural qualifying position. If a car gets artificially moved down in the field due to official stewards decision, or being penalized for any reason, etc. after qualifying that car, it will not be eligible for this race award.

Each race group will have one HARD CHARGER AWARD presented. The winning driver will receive a certificate of award and will be recognized by the race announcer. Each winning driver will also receive a coupon for a \$50 discount to be used toward a future entry at a NEOHIO Region, SCCA Race. This coupon is good for one year from date of issue and must be redeemed at registration for that event.

I was glad to have given her some posters and small die casts of the Merkur a few years back. Competent and caring, we lost amazing ability and incredible friendship in Connie.

Bill Stables, my racing partner of 15 years or so and my friend for much longer, was the same way. A bit of a

grouchy exterior covered a man who helped anybody who asked at the track. There are still many times I wish I could just ask Bill.

Deep in our hearts we feel this is not the way it is supposed to be. God had a better plan but man has made some bad choices. 61 is too young.
