General:

1. Held under the 2011 SCCA *General Competition Rules*. This is a Great Lakes Division Regional Championship Series event. Series rules for series classes are available on the GLD Web site www.greatlakes-scca.org.
2. This event will be open to all drivers holding a valid SCCA membership & licensed per GCR 3.1.5 of 2011 GCR. Be advised we are not able to verify licenses issued by other clubs, you will be responsible to provide current license.
3. The entry fee of \$175.00 includes one car, one driver, 2 days, or \$125.00 includes one driver, one car, 1 day (plus \$10.00 for SRF and FE per day). Includes 3 crew passes additional crew passes are available for \$10 ea. A late entry fee of \$50.00 for entries postmarked after Aug. 16, 2011.
4. Trophies will be given out per the GCR. **In order to keep the entry fee down trophies may be distributed after the event. Make sure the Race Chair has your contact info.**
5. Only one copy of results will be provided to each competitor and must be signed for. **Again this is to keep the cost of your entry down.**
6. **NO Wireless cell phones or computers** will be allowed to be used in or around the Timing & Scoring Tower

Registration:

1. License and proof of membership must be presented at Registration. Drivers needing license and/or membership confirmation from the National office must contact the Chief Registrar no later than 9 PM WEDNESDAY, Aug. 17, 2011, \$5 will be charged for this service.
2. Telephone and online entries are **not official until the entry form is signed, accepted, and all fees are received**. Personal checks, money orders, or cash only will be accepted at the track. A \$50 charge will be assessed on any check returned. The **Chief Registrar** will not be responsible for any entries sent that require a signature or special pick up. If paying by check it **must** be mailed 5-7 days after registered online or entry will be considered late.
3. All drivers, their crew and workers must register before the close of registration signing the SCCA waiver and issued a wristband. **Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action against the responsible driver**. Wristbands and SCCA photo IDs **MUST** be worn at all times. SCCA photo ID's will be available at Registration for \$3.00 each.
4. Car Numbers will be issued on a first come first served basis, postmark will be used. Registrar will notify those who did not receive their number choice.
5. Cancellations must be in writing. E-mail cancellations are acceptable. Full refunds will be given to those entrants who cancel before 9:00 pm, Tuesday, Aug. 16, 2011. A \$50.00 administrative charge will be assessed to cancellations after Tuesday, Aug. 16, 2011. No refund will be provided for cancellation requests after Sept. 22, 2011. Paypal cancellations made after the close of Paypal will be charged the handling fee charged by Paypal to the Region.
6. There will be **NO** Late Entry Registration until one hour after posted Registration opening times, Friday and Saturday.

Conduct of the Event:

1. There will be no waivers on any safety related equipment.
2. The Black Flag station for this event will be at Start/Finish and may be at Station 10.
3. The False Grid will be closed at the one-minute signal. All crew must clear the Grid.
4. Sound level for Nelson Ledges is 103 dbs. See Driver's letter for actions.
5. The Start/Finish line extends through pit lane and will be used for all Timing and Scoring. **A working AMB TRANX 260 Transponder on each car is mandatory. You will not be scored if it is not working properly. Correct transponder number needs to be provided.**
6. Operation of 2 way radios on the following frequencies is not permitted: 151.625 MHz, 154.570 MHz and 154.600 MHz, these frequencies are for event official use only.
7. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited in the paddock **by anyone** until the end of the day's final race activity.
8. Scales may be available see postings at Tech
9. Public address announcements are a courtesy call and drivers are responsible to be on the grid at their required time. Be aware of the group before you being on course.

Track Policies and Services

1. Wristbands provided at Registration must be worn at all times. Participants without wristbands will not gain entry or will be asked to leave the track. Drivers will not be allowed on course without the wristband in place and will be checked by the grid marshals. Replacement wristbands are \$10.00.
2. Only ONE crew member may stand at the pit wall to signal the driver at the discretion of the Chief of Pits.
3. Riding on the outside of any vehicle or trailer is prohibited.
4. Two-, three- and four-wheeled vehicles are prohibited, except for race officials or as race support vehicles. No joy riding. Driver must be at least 18 and have a driver's license issued by their home state. All race support vehicles must prominently display the approved racecar number and class.
5. Un-muffled engines shall not be operated between 8:00 p.m. and 7:30 am.
6. All pets must be restrained AT ALL TIMES and attended by an adult.
7. Camping is permitted for a fee specified by track management. Hookups are not available. Campfires must be contained and attended by an adult at all times. No accelerants may be used.
8. Competitors must remove all tires and used automotive fluids from the premises. Please clean your area before departing the track.
9. Racing fuel may be available in the paddock at **Kryderacing**.
10. Any team with more than 40 gallons of fuel must notify the Safety Steward and Chief of Emergency Services as to their paddock location.
11. Water and air should be available in the paddock.
12. There will be no testing of race cars off the track premises.
13. Complete list of track policies is available at the track office.

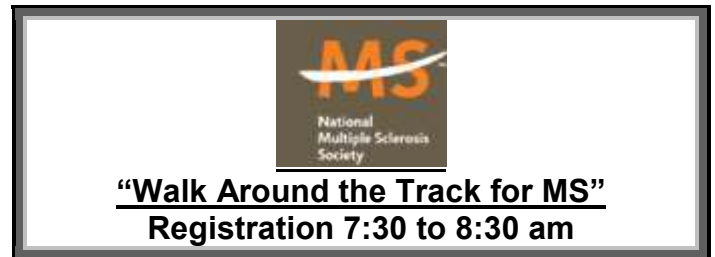
