General

1. Held under the *SCCA General Competition Rules*.
2. This event will be open to all drivers holding a valid SCCA membership and per GCR 3.1.5 holding SCCA Vintage, Regional, and National Competition Licenses and to certain other drivers holding SCCA Novice Permits as provided in Section 4.4.3.E., Racing on a Novice Permit. Regional events shall also be open to Canadian residents holding current ASN National Licenses who are twenty-one (21) years of age or older and who are members of SCCA. The Supplementary Regulations for a Regional event may also provide for the participation of drivers who are members of SCCA holding Competition Licenses issued by other SCCA-approved organizations. Note: the current organizations whose licenses have been approved by SCCA for competition in Regional events are; BMW CCA Club Racing (Full Competition), Confederation of Autosport Car Clubs CACC(Competition), FIA (issued by any sanctioning body), Historic Sportscar Racing (HSR), ICSCC (Area Conference), IMSA, Midwestern Council of Sports Car Clubs MCSCC (Full), *NASA (Competition License)*, Ontario Region CASC (Regional), Porsche Club of America (Full Competition), SCCA Pro Racing, SVRA, Vintage Motorsports Council (VMC), Waterford Hills Road Racing Club (Full), West Canada Motorsport Assoc (Amateur).
3. License and proof of membership must be presented at Registration. Drivers needing license and/or membership confirmation from the National office must contact the Chief Registrar no later than 9 PM TUESDAY, Aug. 18th, 2009, \$5 will be charged for this service.
4. The entry fee of \$150.00 includes one car, one driver, 2 races, or \$100.00 includes 1 driver, 1 car, 1 race (plus \$10.00 for SRF, FE, and SM per race). Includes 3 crew passes additional crew passes are available for \$10 ea. A late entry fee of \$50.00 for entries postmarked after August 14, 2009.
5. Telephone entries are **not official until the entry form is signed, accepted, and all fees are received**. Personal checks, money orders, or cash only will be accepted at the track. A \$50 charge will be assessed on any check returned. The **Chief Registrar** will not be responsible for any entries sent that require a signature or special pick up. If paying by check it **must** be mailed 5-7 days after registered online or entry will be considered late.
6. All drivers, their crew and workers must register before the close of registration signing the SCCA waiver and issued a wristband. **Failure to do so may result in disciplinary action against the responsible driver**. Wristbands and photo IDs **MUST** be worn at all times. Photo ID's will be available at Registration for \$3.00 each.
7. Car Numbers will be issued on a first come first served basis, postmark will be used. Registrar will notify those who did not receive their number choice.

8. Cancellations must be in writing. E-mail cancellations are acceptable. Full refunds will be given to those entrants who cancel before 9:00 pm, Tuesday, Aug 18, 2009. A \$50.00 administrative charge will be assessed to cancellations after Tuesday, Aug 18, 2009. No refund will be provided for cancellation requests after September 24th, 2009.
9. There will be NO Late Entry Registration until one hour after posted Registration opening times, Friday and Saturday.
10. Trophies will be given out per the GCR, **no Trophies will be mailed**.
11. **Novice Permit holders must have an X of contrasting color on the side rear panels of their car.**

Conduct of the Event

1. There will be no waivers on any safety related equipment.
2. The Black Flag station for this event may be Station 10 and Start/Finish.
3. The False Grid will be closed at the one-minute signal. All crew must clear the Grid.
4. All race cars not in their assigned position at this time or cars requiring a push-start will start at the back of the field.
5. Sound level for Nelson Ledges is 103 dbs. See Driver's letter for actions.
6. The Start/Finish line extends through pit lane and will be used for all Timing and Scoring. **A working AMB TRANX 260 Transponder on each car is mandatory.**
7. Operation of 2 way radios on the following frequencies is not permitted: 151.625 MHz, 154.570 MHz and 154.600 MHz, these frequencies are for event official use only.
8. Consumption of alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited in the paddock **by anyone** until the end of the day's final race activity.
9. Scales may be available see postings at Tech.

Track Policies and Services

1. Wristbands provided at Registration must be worn at all times. Participants without wristbands will not gain entry or will be asked to leave the track. Drivers will not be allowed on course without the wristband in place and will be checked by the grid marshals. Replacement wristbands are \$10.00.
2. Only ONE crew member may stand at the pit wall to signal the driver at the discretion of the Chief of Pits.
3. Riding on the outside of any vehicle or trailer is prohibited.
4. Two-, three- and four-wheeled vehicles are prohibited, except for race officials or as race support vehicles. No joy riding. Driver must be at least 18 and have a driver's license issued by their home state. All race support vehicles must prominently display the approved racecar number and class.
5. Un-muffled engines shall not be operated between 8:00 p.m. and 7:30 am.
6. All pets must be restrained AT ALL TIMES by an adult.
7. Camping is permitted for a fee specified by track management. Hookups are not available.
8. Competitors must remove all tires and used automotive fluids from the premises. Please clean your area before departing the track.
9. A complete list of policies is available at the track office.
10. Racing fuel may be available in the paddock at **Kryderacing**.
11. Water and air should be available in the paddock.
12. **Motorsport Ministries** will hold Sunday morning service at the posted time on second floor of the T&S tower.
13. There will be no testing of race cars off the track premises.
